TREE PLANTING PROGRAM

The Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority (ABCA) sells native trees and shrubs to watershed landowners for conservation projects such as windbreaks, watercourse buffers, reforestation of erosion-prone slopes or other marginal agricultural lands.

Grants are available for many projects through federal and provincial cost-share programs and from Huron County through the Huron Clean Water Project. ***Depending on your project you may be eligible for grants of 50% to 100% of the cash costs of your project.*** Projects ineligible for grants will be responsible for the full cost, as shown on this order form. Please contact us for more information.

ABCA provides the following planting services for trees purchased from us:

- \$0.45 per seedling for machine planting and \$0.60 per seedling for hand planting
- \$0.25 per seedling for herbicide application around seedlings
- \$5.00 per tree for planting 2' ball and burlap conifers or 4'-5' deciduous whips
- \$0.60 per tree for herbicide application around large stock
- \$250 fee for preparation of a planting plan that includes administrative costs associated with grant applications and site supervision during planting

Planting services are available to watershed residents only. There is no minimum project size, however a minimum fee of \$350 for planting and \$150 for herbicide application applies to sites less than 1 acre.

Planting Stock:

Trees are ordered from private nurseries to offer to watershed residents. Prices shown on the order form that follows include transportation of trees to Exeter, cold storage and handling.

Trees are grown from locally sourced seed where possible. Species availability is dependent on previous years' natural seed crop and so supply varies annually.

white cedar	to 50'	sand/loam/clay	moist to well drained	sun/part shade	used for windbreaks, moderate growth when young, growth slows with age, will grow on eroded slopes
white pine	100' +	sand/loam/silt loam	well drained	sun/part shade	used in reforestation to initiate succession to hardwoods, susceptible to salt damage
Norway spruce	to 100'	sand/loam/clay	well drained	sun/part shade	used for windbreaks, fast growth once established, this is often the large spruce one sees along old farm lanes
white spruce	to 60'	sand/loam/clay	moist to well drained	sun/part shade	used for windbreaks, does not grow as tall as Norway spruce
blue spruce	to 50'	sand/loam/silt loam	well drained	sun/part shade	drought tolerant once established, moderately tolerant of salt spray
tamarack	to 60'	organic(muck)/loam	well to poorly drained	full sun	tolerates wet soils, fast grower; needles turn yellow in fall and drop, native larch
Austrian pine	to 60'	sand/loam/clay	well drained	full sun	tolerates salt spray, drought, used mainly along roads and for urban/residential trees
Deciduous					
silver maple	to 100'	sand/loam/clay	well to poorly drained	full sun	good trees for moist sites but will also grow on upland sites with heavy soil
sugar maple	to 80'	sand loam to clay	well drained	shade/part shade	important tree for timber and maple syrup production, requires protection from rodents, rabbits and deer
red oak	to 100'	sand/loam/clay	well drained	full sun	excellent wildlife species, requires protection from rodents, rabbits and deer, best growth on well drained loams
bur oak	to 100'	sand/loam/clay	well to imperfectly drained	full sun	excellent wildlife species, requires protection from rodents, rabbits and deer, tolerates a range of soil types, moist to dry
black walnut	to 100'	loam/clay	well drained	full sun	best growth on deep, well drained loams of floodplains or lower slopes
black cherry	to 80'	loam	well drained	full sun	excellent wildlife species, protect from rodents, rabbits and deer, grows fast on well drained loams
common hackberry	to 60'	sand/loam/clay	well drained	sun / part shade	has unique corky ridges on bark, tolerates dry sites but best growth in floodplains

red osier dogwood	to 10'	sand/loam/clay	poorly drained	full sun	white flowers with white fruit, tolerates a wide variety of soils and drainage
staghorn sumac	to 15'	sand/loam/clay	well drained	full sun	red fruit persists in winter, excellent for eroded slopes, spreads by root suckers that prevent erosion, tolerates poor soil
nannyberry viburnum	to 15'	sand/loam/clay	well to poorly drained	full sun	cream flowers and dark purple fruit
highbush cranberry	to 15'	sand/loam/clay	well to poorly drained	full sun	prefers moist soils, red fruit persists in to winter

Mail-in orders must be received by January 31, 2012. An invoice will be mailed to you; payment must be received by ABCA no later than February 29, 2012, to guarantee your order. Orders may be placed in person, accompanied by payment, at the ABCA office until 4 p.m. on Wednesday, February 29, 2012.

CONDITIONS

1. Orders must be in multiples of 10 unless otherwise indicated. Minimum order is 100 seedlings or 20 large stock.
2. Orders not filled due to events beyond the ABCA's control will be refunded.
3. Customers must pick trees up at the ABCA Administration Centre at the above address at scheduled times. Customers are notified of pick-up times using the phone # provided below.
4. Trees purchased through this program are to be used for afforestation, erosion control, and other stewardship projects, not landscaping.
5. Trees are not to be cut, harvested or otherwise removed from the planting area for a minimum of 15 years after planting.
6. The ABCA takes no responsibility for the failure of the stock provided but will take all reasonable precaution to ensure the trees are received in the best possible condition.
7. The landowner agrees to provide protection from grazing, rodents and other damaging agents.
